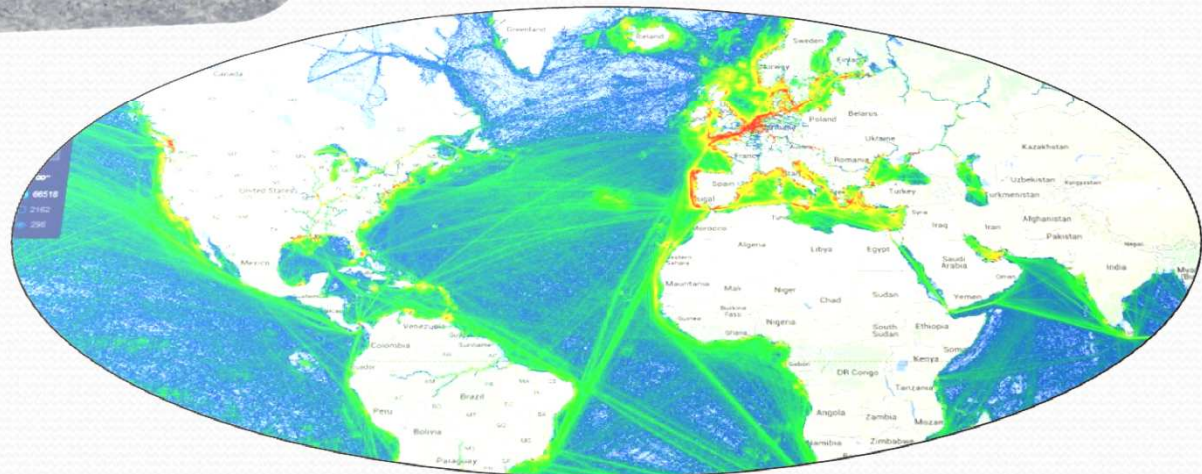

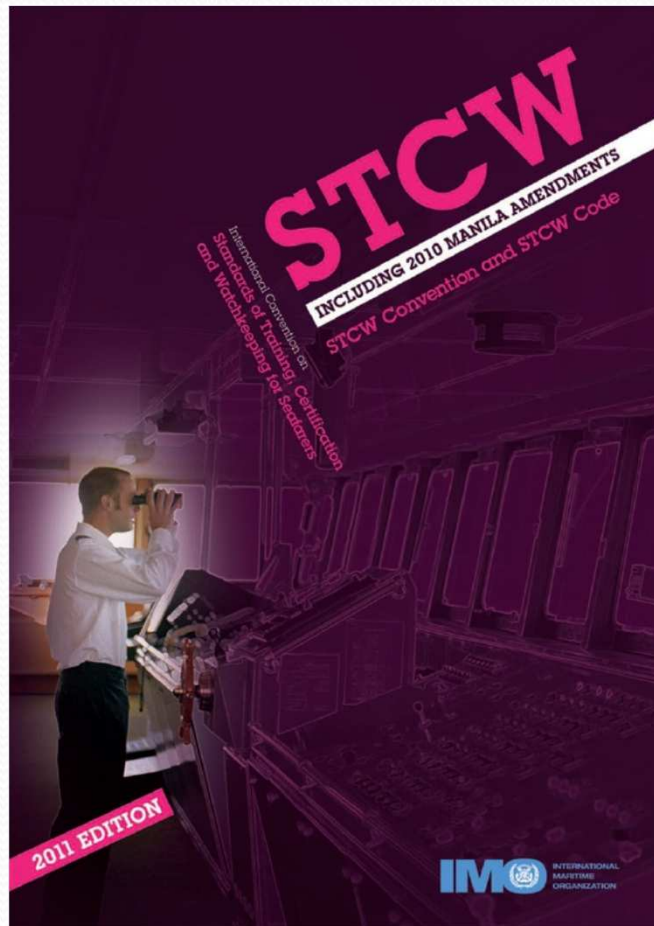
Vessels routes

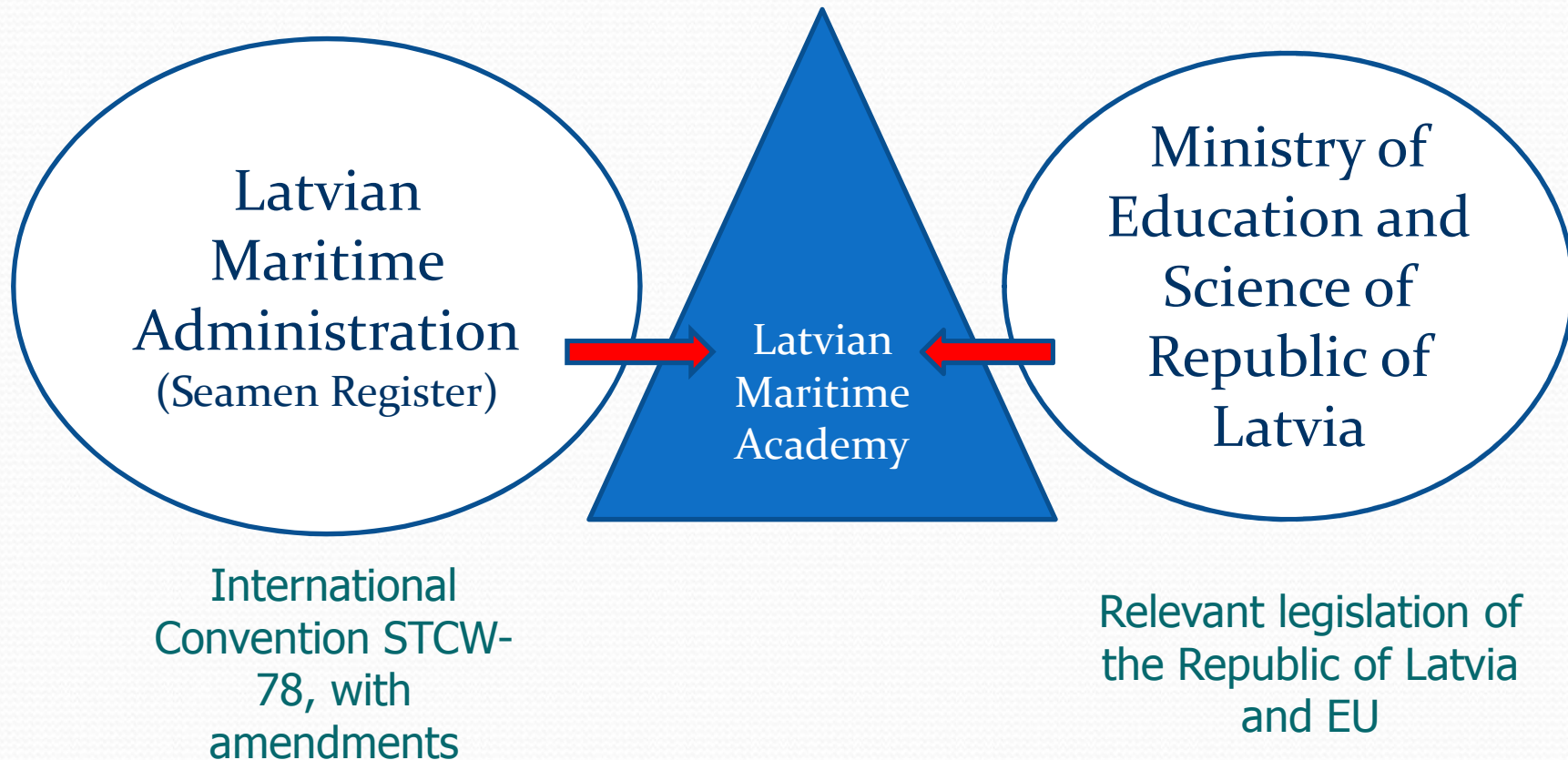
